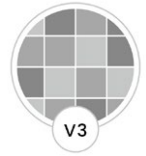

Petrographic Analysis

Compact brown carbonate sedimentary rock with a fine-grained sandstone appearance. The rock is made up of micritic carbonate granules, calcite crystals and a few quartz crystals, all with a good rounding index linked by spathic calcite cement; opaque minerals are also present along the contact areas between the calcite veins and the micritic part.
